This publication series includes various datasets and annual reports prepared for the Rough Cilicia Archaeological Survey Project, and mounted at the Purdue University Digital Research Repository (PURR). The datasets include the Rough Cilicia Survey Project Ceramics Study Collection (350 items); the Rough Cilicia Survey Project Context Ceramics (9400 items), and the [RCSP Annual Reports](#) (Purdue Libraries Epubs, 1996-2011). The datasets are fully searchable and include digital images, profile drawings, and real-world coordinates for the remains and is projected in Google Earth. This is the first of its kind publication of survey ceramics data on-line. The RCSP Study Collection was published in 2018, the Context Pottery is going on line in January-February 2019.
